## Accessibility Declaration



### Statement on accessibility

The Statistical Office in Szczecin declares to ensure the accessibility of its website in accordance with the Act of 4 April 2019 on Digital Accessibility of Websites and Mobile Applications of Public Entities. ### Status in terms of compliance with the Act

The website is partially compliant with the Act of 4 April 2019 on the Digital Accessibility of Websites and Mobile Applications of Public Entities due to the non-compliance and exceptions listed below.

### Unfulfilled requirements

- Some PDF files are digitally inaccessible (their logical structure is not correctly marked or that are scans of documents), the scanned files can be found in the Digital Archive Resources.
- Some of the published infographics do not have an alternative description or an alternative version of the data.
- Some of the published photos do not have an alternative description, however they are not used to carry out current tasks.
- Links with identical accessible name as the content of the link are available.
- The text is fully justified.

## Handling requests and complaints related to availability

Any user has the right to request the digital accessibility of the website, the mobile application or any element thereof. You may also request that the information to be made available using an alternative means of access, such as reading out a digitally inaccessible document, describing the content of a video /film without an audio description, etc. The request should contain the detailed information about the person submitting the request, indication of the website which it concerns and contact information. If the person requests to receive information in an alternative form, the preferred mode of presenting the information should be also specified. The public entity should fulfill the request immediately, no later than within 7 days from the day of the request. If it is not possible to meet this deadline, the public entity should promptly inform the requester when the request will be fulfilled, with the condition that the deadline cannot exceed 2 months from the day of the request. If digital accessibility is not possible, the public entity may propose an alternative way of accessing the information. In case the public entity refuses to comply with the request to ensure the accessibility or an alternative method of access to the information, the person submitting the request may file a complaint regarding the provision of digital accessibility of the website, mobile application or an element of the website or mobile application. After completing the above-mentioned procedure, they can also submit a request to the Commissioner for Human Rights.

- The door opens automatically.
- The doors are transparent and contrastingly marked.

- You can use the elevator.

## Elevator

- The elevator is located in the building.
- The elevator doors open automatically.
- The control buttons are described in Braille.

## Bathroom

- The building has a toilet accessible for people with disabilities.
- You need to open the door with a key.
- If you need to use the toilet, use the bell located opposite the elevators on the ground floor or go to the security of the building.

- There are no obstacles to enter the bathroom in a wheelchair.
